2 Kentucky Board of Licensure and Certification for Dietitians and Nutritionists

3 (Amendment)

4 201 KAR 33:015. Application; approved programs.

5 RELATES TO: KRS 310.021, 310.031(1), (2)

6 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 310.041(1), (2), (6)

7 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 310.041 requires the Kentucky Board

8 of Licensure for Dietitians and Nutritionists to promulgate administrative regulations and to

9 review and approve or reject the qualifications of all applicants for licensure and certification.

10 This administrative regulation establishes the procedure for submitting an application for

11 licensure ~~[or]~~, certification, or dual licensure as a Nutritionist and as a Dietitian; and establishes

12 requirements for ~~[institutions]~~ programs of study to be approved by the board.

13 Section 1. Application.

14 (1) An “Application for Licensure, ~~[or]~~ Certification, or Dual Licensure” shall be submitted for

15 licensure to practice dietetics after the requirements established in KRS 310.021 are met.

16 (2) An “Application for Licensure, ~~[or]~~ Certification, or Dual Licensure” shall be submitted for

17 certification to practice nutrition after the requirements established in KRS 310.031 are met.

18 (3) An “Application for Licensure, Certification, or Dual Licensure” shall be submitted for dual

19 licensure to practice dietetics and nutrition after the requirements established in KRS 310.021

20 and KRS 310.031 are met.

1 ~~(4)~~~~(3)~~ Each “Application for Licensure, ~~[or]~~ Certification, or Dual Licensure” shall be
2 accompanied by the nonrefundable application fee, established in 201 KAR 33:010.

3 ~~(5)~~~~(4)~~ Each application shall be signed by the applicant.

4 ~~(6)~~~~(5)~~ (a) Each application to practice dietetics and each application for dual licensure shall
5 include:

6 1. A copy of the applicant’s current registration card issued by the Commission ~~on~~~~[of]~~ Dietetic
7 Registration; ~~[or]~~

8 2. A letter from the Commission on Dietetic Registration indicating successful completion of the
9 registration examination~~[-]~~; or

10 3. A Credential Verification Statement from the Commission on Dietetic Registration

11 (b) An Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics membership card shall not constitute compliance
12 with paragraph (a)1. of this subsection.

13 ~~(7)~~~~(6)~~ Each application to practice nutrition and each application for dual licensure shall
14 include a certified copy of the applicant’s official master’s transcript or meet the criteria set forth
15 at KRS 310.031(3).

16 ~~(8)~~~~(7)~~ If the applicant is or was licensed or registered in another jurisdiction, the applicant
17 shall:

18 (a) list each jurisdiction and license or registration number;

19 (b) provide a complete licensure disciplinary history; and

20 (c) provide license verification documentation from each respective jurisdiction that is:

21 (i) created by each respective jurisdiction within the sixty (60) days prior to the submission of the
22 application; and

1 (ii) is not a license card, scroll, initial certificate, diploma, or other initial license document.

2 [~~submit a complete Verification of Licensure in Other Jurisdictions form for all jurisdictions~~

3 ~~where the applicant is currently or has formerly been licensed or registered.]~~

4 Section 2. Approved Programs.

5 (1) A baccalaureate degree from a college or university approved by the board pursuant to KRS

6 310.021(3) or 310.031(2)(a) shall be a degree program that is listed as accredited by the

7 Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics.

8 (2) If an applicant's baccalaureate degree is not listed as accredited by the Accreditation Council

9 for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics, then the applicant shall demonstrate at least forty-five

10 (45) semester hours or sixty-eight (68) quarter hours, as evidenced by a certified copy of an

11 academic transcript, of coursework at the baccalaureate or graduate level in addition to the hours

12 required by KRS 310.031(2)(b). The coursework shall include content specific to each of the

13 following areas:

14 (a) Communication;

15 (b) Counseling;

16 (c) Physical and biological sciences;

17 (d) Social sciences;

18 (e) Research;

19 (f) Food composition;

20 (g) Nutrient metabolism;

21 (h) Food systems management;

22 (i) Nutrition therapy;

23 (j) Lifecycle nutrition; and

1 (k) Healthcare systems.

2 (3) The twelve (12) semester hours of graduate credit required by KRS 310.031(2)(b) shall
3 include only didactic hours of graduate credit specifically related to human nutrition. Examples
4 include:

5 (a) Food sources of nutrients;

6 (b) Physiological and chemical processes of digestion, absorption, and metabolism;

7 (c) Nutrient needs throughout the life cycle;

8 (d) Nutrition assessment processes;

9 (e) Pathophysiology of disease states;

10 (f) Medical nutrition therapy;

11 (g) Nutrient needs in exercise and fitness; and

12 (h) Nutrition in health and wellness.

13 (4) The twelve (12) semester hours of graduate credit required by KRS 310.031(2)(b) shall not
14 include practicums, courses that are primarily obtained from work experiences, independent
15 study, thesis, or dissertation credit hours.

16 Section 3. Incorporation by Reference.
